Additional Information:

Located at the corner of N. 9th Street and Chestnut. Owned at one point by two men named Charlie, one of whom was Lady Charles, later owner of Charlie's Lounge. In 1982 the entire block between Pine, Chestnut, 18th and 19th Streets was demolished for the Southwestern Bell / AT&T office building expansion.

Bar and its patrons described in guide books as: "rough trade" and "at your own risk AYOR!" (Guild Guide 1965 – 1970); "Rough downtown bar" ... "some gays...semi-retired hustlers ... some blacks" (Ciao! 1974); raunchy types and older, mature crowd (Damron 1977-79) and 50% men 50% women (Gaia's 1982).
